This Italian tractor company was  
started in an old barn at the end  
of WWII with surplus war  
engines. In 1949, they built a  
completely new factory in Cento  
Italy. At that time they built just  
one tractor each day with a rather  
small group of employees. By  
1958 they built 1500 tractors a  
year and their tractors were  
considered to be among the very  
best. By 1969 production went  
up to 5000 units a year, But in  
1972, after a fatal cancellation of  
an important order, the  
founder lost confidence in his  
tractor business and sold the  
product line. The founder shifted  
production to a different type of  
machine and the name still exists  
and builds something slightly  
faster to this day.
