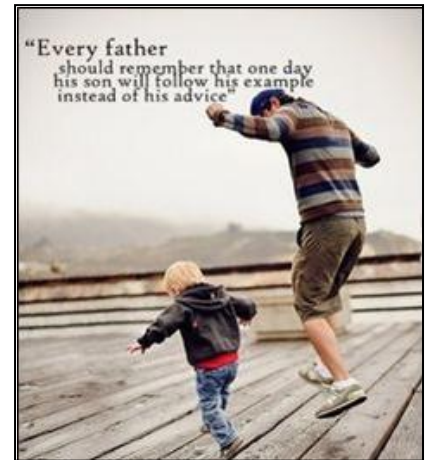

The tractor was designed by H. W. Adams and manufactured in Minneapolis Minnesota. In 1919 it was being offered by the Farm Power & Sales Company of Minneapolis (the Tractor Supply Co. of its time). By 1920 the brand was no longer offered and the company disappeared.
